(2) If officers are to be elected by division or unit write NONE in this space.

(3) The qualifications of a nominee and of an elective officer of a district are determined by the principal act of that district. (Elections Code, § 10514) Generally, the qualification for a resident voting district is "resident elector within the district or division thereof, if any." The qualification for a landowner voting district is "resident and freeholder within the district or division thereof, if any."

(4) NOTE: FPPC Regulations §18530, effective October 10, 1990, ruled that districts can pay for "production and dissemination of candidates statements" notwithstanding Government Code §85300 which forbids use of "public money for promoting candidacies."

NOTE: This notice and transmittal shall be made at least 125 days before the General District Election and shall either be delivered in person or mailed by certified mail in time to reach the County Clerk on the designated date. (Election Code §10504, §10509, §10522, §10524)

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
